

## Voluntary Compliance Disclosure

*(Last Updated: 09/19/2019)*

The Wyoming State Treasurer encourages holders to comply with Wyoming's Unclaimed Property Law, which requires reports be filed annually by November 1. Holders of unclaimed property are required to file reports within the time specified for each type of property, there is no grace period.

Reports and remittances that are received after the required due date are subject to interest and penalties under the provisions of Wyoming Code §24-34-135.

Holders that have never filed a report or may have overlooked certain property types, and would like to come into compliance, are asked to contact our office. Holders that have been granted an "informal voluntary disclosure" will not be subject to penalty.

If, in the course of compiling your annual report of unclaimed property, you find that you will not be able to get your report finished in time for the November 1 deadline, you can request an extension. Please submit an [Extension Request Form](#) to [upreports@wyo.gov](mailto:upreports@wyo.gov).

In addition, please do not report properties earlier than the specified dormancy period. If you have property that has not yet reached the dormancy period and need to report early, please request permission via an [Early Remittance Request Form](#).
