REPORT OF THE STATE TREASURER

The report herewith submitted has been prepared with a view of giving full information in detail of all fiscal transactions of the preceding two years, and the financial condition of the State at the present time. Each cash fund is reported separately, showing the amounts received and expended in each case and a detailed statement of the condition of the appropriation accounts is also given.

Owing to the large number of cash funds and the liability of confusion of titles, reference to the law creating the fund or governing its use is given in each case.

The General Fund, on September 30, 1928, had warrants payable and outstanding aggregating \$289,781.65 as compared with \$808,706.82 outstanding September 30, 1927, and \$625,488.22 outstanding September 30, 1926, the above amounts show the overdraft in the General Fund on the respective dates had all warrants been paid.

The amount of delinquent state tax due the State at this time is somewhat greater than at the corresponding date two years ago. This is due mainly, however, to the fact that the tax levies of the last two years have been larger in amount than formerly, and amounts delinquent are naturally in the same proportion. When considered upon a percentage basis the condition is about the same as usually prevails.

The following Counties, as this report is being completed, were entirely free of taxes due the state: Albany County, Carbon County, Crook County, Johnson County, Hot Springs County, Niobrara County, Platte County, Sublette County, Washakie County and Weston County.

It is a matter for congratulation to the administration of this office, as well as reflecting much credit upon the several Counties of the State, that it has not become necessary for many years past to bring suit against any County for the collection of the tax levied against it. With one or two exceptions all Counties have manifested an earnest desire to pay up their delinquencies as fast as possible and this office has been able to adjust all differences and arrive at a settlement from time to time without friction or lawsuit. However, it seems improbable that we will be able to continue without bringing suit against several of the Counties that are delinquent.

The total receipts from the Land Department during the period covered by this report have been \$3,610,559.18 as compared with \$4,956,056.11, showing a decrease of \$1,345,496.93 for the two years ending September 30, 1928. These figures include only the actual amounts received from the Commissioner of Public Lands, and are exclusive of amounts received from other sources, but which may properly be credited to our land income. These would include the five per cent sales of United States lands, \$1,778.51; interest received on investment of permanent land funds \$1,064,924.65; interest on deposits of land funds (including interest on Trust Funds received from the Land Department) \$86,573.05; and funds received from the United States as royalty on production of oil and other minerals \$3,633,827.93; a grand total of \$4,787,104.14.

The State Treasurer, with the approval of the Governor and Attorney General, has purchased during the past two years, bonds of Counties, School Districts, Municipalities, Drainage and Irrigation Districts of the State to the amount of \$3,545,500.00. During the same period bonds held as such investment have matured and been paid in the sum of \$631,910.00. The total amount of bonds held September 30, 1928, was \$18,121,885.53. These figures include \$249,464.39 invested in State Warrants and \$5,387,271.14 invested in Farm Loans.

Special care has been taken in the purchase of bonds during the past two years, and owing to the decrease in interest rates, securities of a desirable nature have been difficult to obtain, however the investments made by the present administration are considered to be first class in every respect.

I call attention at this time to certain bond issues on which the interest payments are delinquent, being as follows:

Referring to the delinquencies mentioned above, I would recommend that prompt action be taken in order that the Permanent Funds of the State be protected as contemplated by Statute.

During the past two years \$18,000.00 of Public Building Bonds have been paid. One Bond of this issue \$1,000.00 is outstanding. This Bond was called for payment July 1, 1928. There now remains \$1,901,000.00 of bonded indebtedness, as follows:

A statement in detail is included in this report, showing the total amount of bonds issued and amounts paid to September 30, 1928.

The State Treasurer has collected in interest on bank deposits during the past two years a total of \$150,718.27. From interest on investments there have been collected \$1,064,924.65, making a grand total of \$1,215,642.92.

The following detailed statements show the financial transactions of the past two years and the condition of the Treasury at the present time.

The rate of interest fixed by the Board to be paid by State Depositories upon deposits of State Funds for the year

beginning May 1, 1927, was two per centum and for the year beginning May 1, 1928, was two per centum upon daily balances.
